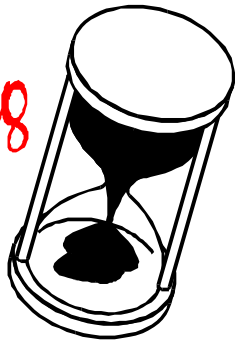

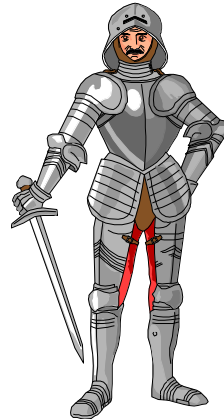
Our meeting #1641 on 4 June 2018 was attended by only 3 members and we failed to muster a quorum (4 members required). Further justification for the proposed merger.
